
Carex muskingumensis 'Bicolor'

Nr. 4639: Upright growing Carex with cream white – green striped leaves. Very nice in combinations. Winter hardy but not reliably wintergreen. Trimming in spring is recommended.

Carex testacea 'Prairie Fire'

Nr. 2522: Starting olive-green, the foliage turns towards orange-brown by September. Best grown outdoor. Good drainage and protection help for overwintering.



Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'

Nr. 1515: A dainty, elegant form of calmus with nodding foliage. A structural element that retains its beautiful habit and color throughout the winter.









Carex hachijoensis 'Evergold' Nr. 1540: A clump-forming sedge with elegant, slightly undulate leaves. Problem-free, tough

and a real eyecatcher in combos.

Carex 'Ribbon Falls' (ET CRX02(S)) **Nr. 4441:** Blue-green sedge, nice in combinations or to plant under trees/shrubs; for sunny and shady locations. Winter hardy and evergreen.

Nr. 1539: Very robust specialty variety. Evergreen

Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance' Nr. 1505: Fountain-like morrowii variety; easy and fast in cultivation; for the end consumer very hardy and durable.



Carex morrowii x foliosis. 'Vanilla Ice². (VANICE(S)) **Nr. 1567:** Particularly elegant, vigorous sedge with about 30cm long leaves, which first grow upwards and later are nodding.

Carex oshimensis 'Everest' (FIWHITE(S)) **Nr. 2884:** Complement to 'Evergold' with longer foliage that is dark green with creamy-white margins. Sun tolerant, winter hardy and evergreen.

Carex oshimensis 'Eversheen' (EVERSHEEN(S)) Nr. 2869: Good basal branching. Rich in contrast and more intense coloration than 'Evergold'.





Nr. 1562: Semi-vigorous sedge. Good basal branching and fast to grow. Winter hardy and evergreen.

Carex albula 'Frosted Curl Nr. 1521: A very fine-leaved, dainty sedge from New Zealand. Somewhat more sensitive and less hardy than other sedges but easy in cultivation.

Carex comans 'Amazon Mist' Nr. 2501: Dainty sedge with mint-green leaves and silvery-white underside. Clump-forming, pendulous foliage with a total height of about 30 cm.





Nr. 1543: A slender, stiffly upright, clump-forming sedge hailing from New Zealand. Reaches a height of about 40 cm. Easy and reliable in cultivation.



Carex panicea


Nr. 1507: A small, hummock-forming, almost prostrate sedge; very intense color very healthy. It produces an excellent pot quality.







Festuca cinerea 'Azurit' Nr. 2819: Hummock-forming fescue with longer, steel-blue leaves. Quick to grow.



Festuca cinerea 'Green Form' Nr. 2810: Attractive, moss-green fesue with longish, slightly droopy leaves. Robust and evergreen.





Nr. 2801: Beyond a doubt the most intense blue color of all the fescue varieties. Grows to a height of 30 cm, resp. 50 cm when in flower. Frost hardy and robust.





Nr. 2509: The clump-forming Koeleria is easy to grow and like fescue flowers in the second year. Winter hardy and evergreen.



Pen. alopecur. 'Hameln Gold' (HAMELN GOLD(S)), **Nr. 2070:** Nice selection for the original variety 'Hameln' with leaves in a citrus-yellow coloration.



Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hameln' Nr. 2063: Compact form oft he fountain grass (30 to 60 cm). In late summer, many cylindrical flower spikes appear. Dormant in winter.

Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Little Bunny' Nr. 2062: *Especially dwarf and elegant fountain grass, that is studded with many short flowers pikes. Total height of 30 to 40 cm. Hardy, but not evergreen.*

Stipa tenuissima 'Pony Tails' Nr. 2513: Selection of the Mexixan Feather Gras with soft leaves. Silvery spikes with long awns appear up from August.

Our selection of "tall grasses" consists of varieties which are well suited for pot cultivation and can be used to upgrade our seasonal assortments. We offer strong young plants with excellent basal branching that allow a quick and easy production.



Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Red Head' Nr. 4644: Impressive reddish flower-fronds decorate this winter hardy fountain grass by late summer. 'Red Head' grows upright to a height of 60-80 cm.

Miscanthus 'Gold Breeze' (GOLD BREEZE(S)) Nr. 1538: Compact Miscanthus with yellow-green horizontal stripes and a total height of about 80 cm. 'Gold Breeze' is best suitalbe for smaller container sizes. Silvery flower spikes in September/October (usually in the second year).





Eragrostis spectabilis 'Purple Love Grass' Nr. 2849: From mid-August through October, countless purplish-brown flower heads are produced that completely cover the plants with cloud-like inflorescences. Height between 40-60 cm.

Imperata 'Red Baron'

Nr. 2816: Japanese blood grass with bright red foliage. Sensitive to waterlogging and not reliably hardy. Prefers well-drained soils, warm sites in partial shade. Height about 40 cm, rarely flowers.

Phalaris arundinacea 'Pure Gold' Nr. 2833: Conspicuous, bright lemon-yellow foliage with excellent basal branching. Interesting summer grass variety for mixed combos.



Cortaderia 'Pumila'; Nr. 2815: A compact form ot the popular "pampas gras" with silver-white flower heads from September onwards. This dwarf from is reputed to have a better winter hardiness than the species. However, the most important factor is to provide good drainage at all times.

Miscanthus sinensis 'Kleine Silberspinne Nr. 2805: Dainty, tight clumps with narrow, darkgreen foliage and profuse flowering from August onwards with silver, feathery spikes. Foliage height: 50 cm, with flowers 100 cm. Good winter hardiness, attractive well into winter.

Panicum virgatum 'Cheyenne Sky' Nr. 2824: Dark blue-green foliage that turns reddishpurple and bronze from August onwards; purple spikes, height 80-120 cm.

Cortaderia selloana 'Senior'

Nr. 2814: reichblütige Spitzensorte (90-250 cm) mit auffallend langen, dichten Blüten von September bis Oktober, die silbrigweiß glänzen. > Rich flowering variety (90-250 cm) with long and tight flowers in silvery-white from September to October.



Miscanthus purpurascens 'Adagio Nr. 2803: Dainty, fine-leaved selection out of the Yakushima group. Feathery flower heads appear from September onward. Foliage height 100 cm, in flower 150 cm. Full hardy and attractive into winter.





Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Pennstripe'; Nr. 2077: Creamy-yellow to green variegated selection from Australia with long, slender leaves and very good drought resistance. The winter hardy 'Pennstripe' flowers rarely.
